



## ENERGY Habitat

ENERGY Habitat is used in environments where hot work normally is not permitted. ENERGY Habitat prevents ignition sources - such as sparks - from coming into contact with flammable or explosive gases.

This is achieved in two ways. Gas is prevented from entering the habitat due to over-pressure; and sparks are prevented from leaving the habitat by the habitat walls, which are made of strong, flame-retardant sheeting. ENERGY Habitat meets the Norsok standard for Ex/Atex equipment, and is certified for use in both Zone 1 and Zone 2.
